Project Description	<p>Millions of people die every year from diseases associated with unsafe drinking water, sanitation and hygiene.</p> <p>ENF is facing a challenge of water shortages at the restaurant that requires immediate attention. The same holds for UCMTI. For the past 3 months, there has been a water shortage at both premises. The National water is insufficient and can only act as a backup. Currently when there is</p>			



	<p>a water shortage, the two places suffer so much especially with sanitary facilities that have flushable toilets. The solution is to buy water from outside which is so costly (for cooking, bathing, sanitary facilities and drinking) and this poses a very big health challenge for our clients and the students respectively because of health precautions. Due to different types of solid and liquid waste generation by different activities like industrial, vehicular, construction, and domestic, water quality has deteriorated in Kampala, leading to the threat of health hazards for our clients and the UCMTI students. The students are currently on holiday but during the previous semester, water shortages was a major problem. The aim is to complete the work and have sufficient water before the students return from their holidays in August. Following this background. ENF and UCMTI joined forces to find a quick solution; drilling a borehole through cost sharing, UCMTI contributed 3 million shillings and this was contributed towards the assessment and buying of the materials to work. ENF shared this information with the Board and they decided to fundraise towards this cause at the fundraiser as their contribution. A total of 2.2 million cash was collected at the fundraiser and this has been added to the money for the project. Total contribution from UCMTI and ENF is UGX 5.2 million shillings. Some materials have been bought and work is ongoing. However, the project has a deficit of UGX 18,989,000 million shillings to be completed and get access to clean water for the school and restaurant.</p>
